In addition, renewable energy sources are used, with the resort operating its own biogas facility. The organic production of fruit and vegetables is yet another environmental benefit. Great importance is also attached to waste reduction. The Maritim Hotel itself, in keeping with the resort as a whole, is involved in the Zero Waste tourism project which aims to produce as little waste as possible. Furthermore, the resort is situated on the doorstep of one of Bulgaria's most beautiful nature reserves, the Baltata.
